MUNICIPALITIES. Provides for the governing authority of the Parish of East Baton Rouge and the public bid process. (gov sig)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Deletes proposed law and instead requires that all bidders shall submit bid forms required by statute or the Louisiana Administrative Code, rather than the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, to the governing authority of East Baton Rouge Parish before the opening of all bids relative to a contract for public works.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, all bidders shall submit all bid forms required by statute or by the Louisiana Administrative Code to the governing authority of East Baton Rouge Parish prior to the opening of all bids relative to a contract for public works.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
