Honore (HB 59) Act No. 183

<u>Prior law</u> provided that an offender may be awarded up to 90 days toward the reduction of the projected good time parole supervision date for satisfactory participation in certified treatment or rehabilitation programs, but no offender shall receive more than 250 days total earned credits for program participation.

<u>New law</u> increases the total number of credits that may be earned by an individual offender for participation in such programs <u>from</u> 250 days <u>to</u> 360 days.

Effective August 1, 2013.
