1	AN ACT
2	To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2014-
3	2015 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Robert L. Knippers
4	and Lessie T. Knippers v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of
5	Transportation and Development and Gilchrist Company, LLC"; and to provide for
6	related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. The sum of Thirty Thousand and No/100 (\$30,000.00) Dollars is hereby
9	appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 to
10	be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Robert L. Knippers and Lessie T.
11	Knippers v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development
12	and Gilchrist Company, LLC", bearing Number 59,598-A on the docket of the Eleventh
13	Judicial District Court, parish of Sabine, state of Louisiana.
14	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2014; if vetoed by the governor
15	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
16	2014, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
