Lopinto HB No. 106

Abstract: Requires that motor vehicle license plates be clearly and visibly displayed in an upright position in the rear of the motor vehicle.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S.47:507) provides that motor vehicle permanent registration plates be securely fastened to the assigned motor vehicle in an manner to prevent the plate from swinging, and at a height not less than 12 inches from the ground from the bottom of such plate in a place and position to be clearly visible, and shall be maintained free from foreign materials and in a condition to be clearly legible.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that all permanent registration plates be affixed to the motor vehicle in an upright position to be clearly visible.
