1 AN ACT 2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2014-3 2015 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Rex Allen Kimble, 4 Allen Paul Kimble and Stacy Wayne Kimble v. State of Louisiana, through the 5 Department of Transportation and Development"; and to provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. The sum of Fifteen Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Two and No/100 8 (\$15,272.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana 9 for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Rex 10 Allen Kimble, Allen Paul Kimble and Stacy Wayne Kimble v. State of Louisiana, through 11 the Department of Transportation and Development", bearing Number 2011-6680-B on the 12 docket of the Twelfth Judicial District Court, parish of Avoyelles, state of Louisiana. 13 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2014; if vetoed by the governor 14 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1, 15 2014, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
