CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES: Adds certain compounds to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law

6	Section 1. R.S. 40:964(Schedule II)(E)(3), (Schedule III)(B)(15), and (Schedule
7	IV)(D)(13) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

Abstract: Adds certain substances to Schedules II, III, and IV.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the designation of controlled dangerous substances into Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V based upon the substances' potential for addiction and abuse.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds 4-anilino-N-phenethyl-4-piperidine (ANPP) as an immediate precursor to fentanyl to Schedule II.

Proposed law adds perampanel to Schedule III.

Proposed law adds lorcaserin to Schedule IV.
