Abstract: Requires a signed donor consent form as evidence of executing an anatomical gift through the office of motor vehicles.

<u>Present law</u>, in pertinent part, specifies that a donor may make an anatomical gift by authorizing a statement or symbol indicating that he has made an anatomical gift to be imprinted on his driver's license or identification card.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by specifying that a donor must execute a donor consent form to authorize a statement or symbol indicating that he has made an anatomical gift to be imprinted on his driver's license or identification card.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a procurement organization must be allowed reasonable access to information in the records of the office of motor vehicles to ascertain a person's donor status.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but specifies that a procurement organization must have reasonable access to the signed donor consent form.
