2	To enact R.S. 49:170.19, relative to honorary designations; to declare fox pen hunting as
3	part of the folklife heritage of the state; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 49:170.19 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	<u>§170.19. Folklife heritage</u>
7	It is hereby declared that fox pen hunting is part of the folklife heritage of the
8	state and, as such, should be preserved in order to help maintain the folklife culture.
