AN ACT

To enact R.S. 33:4690.13, relative to local governing authorities; to provide additional notice to property owners of public works projects; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:4690.13 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§4690.13. Additional notice to certain property owners

Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, in addition to any notice required by law relative to a pending public works project by any parish or municipality, and at least ten days prior to the public hearing, a good faith attempt to notify the owner or owners of record of the property directly affected by the public works project shall be made by sending an official notice by regular mail of the time and place of the public hearing and the general subject matter of the proposed public works project.

Proposed law adds an additional notice requirement via regular mail 10 days prior to a public hearing to property owners whose property will be affected by any parish or municipality public works project.

Effective August 1, 2014.
