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Montoucet HB No. 419

Abstract: Provides that no person shall refuse to grant access to any natural or artificial public drainage by a local governing authority, drainage district, or other public entity charged with maintaining the public drainage.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 38:214) provides that no person shall dump or discharge or permit to be dumped or discharged into any waters or drains of the state any trees or other objects, substances, or materials which might interfere with the drainage.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 38:215) provides that no person shall willfully obstruct any natural or artificial drainage canal, creek, bayou, or small river, or any public or private drainage.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no person shall refuse to grant access to any natural or artificial public drainage by a local governing authority, drainage district, or other public entity charged with maintaining the public drainage.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that in any action in a court of competent jurisdiction where the court is required to determine the right of access to the public drainage, the prevailing party shall be entitled to an award of court costs and attorney fees incurred by the prevailing party.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "public drainage" as any existing natural or artificial drainage ditch, drain, culvert, canal, creek, bayou, or small river.
