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Cromer HB No. 435

Abstract: Requires professional employer organizations (PEOs) to file registration statements with commissioner of insurance annually; requires the commissioner charge a fee of \$500 for filing of the initial statement and \$300 for filing of each subsequent annual statement.

Present law requires PEOs to file their registration statements with the Dept. of Insurance.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires PEOs to file their registration statements with the commissioner of insurance.

<u>Present law</u> states that the Dept. of Insurance may charge a fee to cover its costs in receiving and maintaining the statements not to exceed \$500 for filing of the initial registration statement and \$300 for each annual statement.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the commissioner of insurance to charge a fee of \$500 for the filing of the initial registration statement and \$300 for filing of the annual statement.

<u>Present law</u> requires that PEOs consider the client's employees as a separate group for the purposes of eligibility, rating, and coverage.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and requires that PEOs issue a separate policy to each client for its employees, with the client as the plan sponsor.
