INSURANCE: Repeals provisions relative to dental referral plans

To repeal Subpart H of Part III of Chapter 4 of Title 22 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of
1950, comprised of R.S. 22:1161 through 1167, relative to dental referral plans; to
repeal provisions relative to dental referral plans.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 22:1161 through 1167, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Abstract:** Repeals provisions related to dental referral plans.

<u>Present law</u> defines a dental referral plan as a contractual plan that provides a list of dental care providers who have agreed to provide treatment to enrollees in the plan for specific fees.

<u>Present law</u> requires dental referral plans to register with the commissioner of insurance and provides procedures for registration.

<u>Present law</u> requires renewal of registration every two years and payment of an initial registration and renewal fee of \$250.

<u>Present law</u> allows the imposition of a money penalty of up to \$2,500 for violations of <u>present law</u>.

Proposed law repeals present law.
