Barrow HB No. 546

Abstract: Provides that monthly restitution amounts cannot exceed 15% of the defendant's monthly income.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the court can order a defendant to pay restitution to a victim.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that if the defendant is found to be indigent and therefore unable to make restitution in full at the time of conviction, the court shall order a periodic payment plan consistent with the person's financial ability; however, no court shall order a monthly periodic payment plan which exceeds fifteen percent of the defendant's monthly income.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that in no case shall a defendant be incarcerated for failure to pay restitution.
