HOUSE BILL NO. 609

BY REPRESENTATIVE ABRAMSON

PROPERTY/PUBLIC: Provides with respect to state property in Orleans parish

1 AN ACT

2 To authorize and provide for the transfer of certain state property; to authorize the transfer  
3 of certain state property in Orleans Parish; to provide for reservation of mineral  
4 rights; to provide terms and conditions; to provide an effective date; and to provide  
5 for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The commissioner of administration, notwithstanding any other provision  
8 of law to the contrary, is hereby authorized and empowered to convey, transfer, assign, lease,  
9 or deliver any interest, excluding mineral rights, the state may have to all or any portion of  
10 a parcel of state property in Orleans Parish.

11 Section 2. The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized to enter into  
12 such agreements, covenants, conditions, and stipulations and to execute such documents as  
13 necessary to properly effectuate any conveyance, transfer, assignment, lease, or delivery of  
14 title, excluding mineral rights, to the property described in Section 1 of this Act, and as more  
15 specifically described in any such agreements entered into and documents executed by the  
16 commissioner of administration, in exchange of consideration proportionate to the appraised  
17 value of the property.

18 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
19 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
20 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

- 1 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
2 effective on the day following such approval.
