HOUSE BILL NO. 633

INSURANCE/HEALTH: Provides relative to coverage of HIV/AIDS medications by health insurers

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 22:980.1, relative to premium payments by third parties; to require health
3 insurers to accept third-party premium payments made pursuant to the federal Ryan
4 White HIV/AIDS Program; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 22:980.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §980.1. Third-party premium payments

8 No health insurer regulated by this Part shall refuse to accept third-party
9 premium payments made pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 300ff-26, including third-party
10 premium payments for qualified health plans sold on a federal health insurance
11 exchange.

12 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
13 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
14 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
15 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
16 effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Requires healthcare insurers to accept third-party premium payments made pursuant to the Ryan White HIV/AIDS program.

Proposed law requires healthcare insurers to accept premium payments made by a third party for health insurance policies purchased on behalf of individuals pursuant to grants made through the federal Ryan White HIV/AIDS program.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
