## DIGEST

Chabert (SB 357)

<u>Present law</u> requires that any person who imports or privately possesses a constrictor or venomous snakes have a permit issued by the DW&F. Makes an exception for animal sanctuaries, zoos, aquariums, wildlife research centers, scientific organizations, and medical research facilities as defined by the U.S. Animal Welfare Act.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the importation or private possession of constrictor and venomous snakes but retains the <u>present law</u> exemption for animal sanctuaries, zoos, aquariums, wildlife research centers, scientific organizations, and medical research facilities as defined by the U.S. Animal Welfare Act.

Effective August 1, 2014.
