HB No. 835

Abstract: Provides for the unlawful possession, sales, purchase, and distribution of alternative nicotine products and vapor products to minors.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the unlawful possession, sales, purchase, and distribution of tobacco products to minors.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds alternative nicotine products and vapor products to the <u>present law</u> prohibitions.

Proposed law defines "alternative nicotine product" and "vapor product".

<u>Proposed law</u> excludes alternative nicotine products and vapor products from the definition of tobacco.

<u>Present law</u> provides that in order to prevent persons under 18 years of age from purchasing or receiving tobacco products from vending machines or self-service displays, the sale or delivery of tobacco products through a vending machine or self-service display is prohibited.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds alternative nicotine products and vapor products to the <u>present law</u> prohibitions.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
