MINERALS: Provides relative to plugging and abandoning of disposal wells and injection wells and restoration of such well sites

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 30:4(C)(16)(a), 4.1(B)(1), and 83(B), relative to plugging and
3	abandoning of wells; to require the commissioner of conservation to take certain
4	actions relative to disposal wells and injection wells; to provide relative to the
5	membership of the Oilfield Site Restoration Commission; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 30:4(C)(16)(a), 4.1(B)(1), and 83(B) are hereby amended and
9	reenacted to read as follows:
10	§4. Jurisdiction, duties, and powers of the assistant secretary; rules and regulations

12	C. The commissioner has authority to make, after notice and hearings as
13	provided in this Chapter, any reasonable rules, regulations, and orders that are
14	necessary from time to time in the proper administration and enforcement of this
15	Chapter, including rules, regulations, or orders for the following purposes:

17	(16)(a) To regulate by rules, the drilling, casing, cementing, disposal
18	interval, monitoring, plugging and permitting of disposal wells which are used to
19	inject waste products in the subsurface and to regulate all surface and storage waste
20	facilities incidental to oil and gas exploration and production, in such a manner as

The assistant secretary of the office of conservation of the Department of Natural Resources, hereafter referred to as the "assistant secretary", shall have authority to make, after notice and hearings as provided in this Chapter, any reasonable rules, regulations, and orders that are necessary from time to time in the proper administration and enforcement of this Section including, but not limited to rules, regulations, or orders for the following purposes:

7	(1) The secretary of the Department of Natural Resources, who shall serve
8	as the chairman and the assistant secretary, who shall serve as vice chairman. The
9	undersecretary of the department may serve as a proxy member of the board in the
10	absence of the secretary with full authority to act for the secretary as a member of
11	the board.
12	(2) One person appointed by the governor, who shall serve at the pleasure
13	of the governor.
14	(3) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons
15	submitted by the Louisiana Mid-Continent Oil and Gas Association for an initial
16	term of four years. The secretary of the Department of Environmental Quality. The
17	undersecretary of the department may serve as a proxy member of the board in the
18	absence of the secretary and shall have full authority to act for the secretary when
19	serving as a member of the board.
20	(4) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons

11	(8) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons
12	nominations submitted by representatives of the Louisiana division of the Sierra
13	Club, the Louisiana Wildlife Federation, and the Louisiana division of the Audubon
14	Society, the Louisiana Audubon Council who shall serve an initial term of three
15	years.
16	(9) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons
17	nominations submitted by the Nature Conservancy for an initial term of three years.
18	(10) The assistant secretary for the office of conservation or his designee
19	shall serve as vice chairman of the commission. The assistant secretary shall not be
20	counted to determine the number needed to constitute a quorum but shall be counted
21	to establish a quorum. When the secretary is present, the assistant secretary shall not
22	be a voting member. The assistant secretary for the office of conservation may serve
23	as a proxy member of the board in the absence of the secretary and he shall have full
24	authority to act for the secretary when serving as a member of the board.

HB No. 957

Abstract: Changes the membership of the Oilfield Site Restoration Commission and requires the commissioner of conservation to do certain things relative to disposal wells and injection wells.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the jurisdiction, duties, and powers of the commissioner of conservation. Authorizes the commissioner to regulate disposal wells and injection wells and other items and facilities associated with such wells including requiring the plugging and abandoning of abandoned wells or wells of no further use. Authorizes the commissioner to require reasonable surety bond for such plugging and abandoning.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the commissioner to require the plugging of abandoned wells and wells that are of no further use and require surety bond associated with such activities.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Oilfield Site Restoration Commission and charges that commission with the responsibility to approve a priority list for oilfield site restoration efforts by the Dept. of Natural Resources, review such activities, and administer and manage the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund. Provides that the commission be composed of the following:

- (1) The secretary of the Dept. of Natural Resources, who shall serve as the chairman and the assistant secretary, who shall serve as vice chairman.
- (2) One person appointed by the governor, serving at the pleasure of the governor.
- (3) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons submitted by the Louisiana Mid-Continent Oil and Gas Association for an initial term of four years.
- (4) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons submitted by the Louisiana Mid-Continent Oil and Gas Association for an initial term of two years.
- (5) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons submitted by the Louisiana Independent Oil and Gas Association who shall serve an initial term of four years.
- (6) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons submitted by the Louisiana Independent Oil and Gas Association who shall serve an initial term of two years.
- (7) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons submitted by the Louisiana Landowners Association who shall serve an initial term of three years.
- (8) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons submitted by representatives of the Louisiana division of the Sierra Club, the Louisiana Wildlife Federation, and the Louisiana division of the Audubon Society, who shall serve an initial term of three years.
- (9) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three persons submitted by the Nature Conservancy for an initial term of three years.

<u>Proposed law</u> alters the membership to be as follows:

- (1) The secretary of the Dept. of Natural Resources, who shall serve as the chairman.
- (2) One person appointed by the governor, who shall serve at the pleasure of the governor.
- (3) The secretary of the Dept. of Environmental Quality. The undersecretary of the department may serve as a proxy member of the board in the absence of the secretary and shall have full authority to act for the secretary when serving as a member of the board.
- (4) The secretary of the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries. The undersecretary of the department may serve as a proxy member of the board in the absence of the secretary and shall have full authority to act for the secretary when serving as a member of the board.
- (5) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three nominations submitted by the Delta Chapter Sierra Club, who shall serve an initial term of four years.
- (6) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three nominations submitted by the Louisiana Wildlife Federation, who shall serve an initial term of two years.
- (7) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three nominations submitted by the Louisiana Landowners Association who shall serve an initial term of three years.
- (8) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three nominations submitted by the Louisiana Audubon Council who shall serve an initial term of three years.
- (9) One person appointed by the governor from a list of three nominations submitted by the Nature Conservancy for an initial term of three years.
- (10) The assistant secretary for the office of conservation or his designee shall serve as vice chairman of the commission. The assistant secretary shall not be counted to determine the number needed to constitute a quorum but shall be counted to establish a quorum. When the secretary is present, the assistant secretary shall not be a voting member. The assistant secretary for the office of conservation may serve as a proxy member of the board in the absence of the secretary and shall have full authority to act for the secretary when serving as a member of the board.
