Current law does not provide for the permitting of brokers.

Proposed law defines a broker an agent of one or more licensed dealers for whom they solicit, receive, or transmit orders for beverages with alcohol content greater than 6% but do not maintain an inventory, possess a property right, or deliver any beverage alcohol products. The bill creates a permit for brokers that is identical to that of solicitors, including the fee of \$5 per year.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The bill is expected to increase self-generated revenue by the amount of broker permit fees collected at \$5 each per year. It is not known exactly how many brokers are or will be conducting business in the state. A reasonable assumption is that there are fewer brokers than solicitors. There are currently 5,100 permitted solicitors in the state with associated permit fees of \$25,500. Thus, the revenue generated by the broker permit is expected to be less than \$25,500, annually, though the actual amount is uncertain.
