SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4

BY SENATOR RISER

LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS. Designates the month of March 2014 as "Breast Cancer Awareness Month".

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To designate March 2014 as "Breast Cancer Awareness Month" in Louisiana.
3	WHEREAS, because breast cancer typically produces no symptoms when the tumor
4	is small and most easily cured, it is very important for women to follow recommended
5	screening guidelines for detecting breast cancer at an early stage; and
6	WHEREAS, according to the Centers for Disease Control, over two hundred
7	thousand Americans are diagnosed with breast cancer annually and nearly fifty thousand die
8	each year from breast cancer; and
9	WHEREAS, while the overwhelming percentage of breast cancer sufferers are
10	women, breast cancer is diagnosed in more than forty thousand men annually; and
11	WHEREAS, breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death for all women
12	in the United States and the leading overall cause of cancer death in women between the
13	ages of twenty and fifty-nine; and
14	WHEREAS, as more attention is focused upon breast cancer and earlier detection
15	results, the number of breast cancer survivors has risen to over three million currently in the
16	United States; and
17	WHEREAS, African American women diagnosed with breast cancer are more likely
18	to die as a result of that cancer diagnosis than Caucasian women and are less likely to

1	survive five years beyond diagnosis; and
2	WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control studies indicate that these poor
3	outcomes result primarily from being diagnosed at a later stage in the disease and receiving
4	treatment at a later stage; and
5	WHEREAS, presumably, increased knowledge of the warning signs and increased
6	public attention on breast cancer will result in more timely diagnoses and treatment and an
7	increase in survival rates especially for African American women; and
8	WHEREAS, nearly forty thousand American women will die from breast cancer this
9	year; and
10	WHEREAS, Louisiana has one of the highest rates of deaths from breast cancer in
11	the United States.
12	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
13	designate March 2014 as "Breast Cancer Awareness Month".
