| 5 | recognized as the first modern order of merit; and |
| 6 | WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Harry Lazarus Jr. was awarded the medal in a |
| 7 | ceremony at a meeting of the Galvez chapter of the Sons of the American Revolution in |
| 8 | Shreveport, Louisiana; and |
| 9 | WHEREAS, it was bestowed to him by the Honorary Consul of France, Dana Krees; |

| 11 | WHEREAS, Lt. Col. Lazarus served in the 75 th Infantry Division of the United States |
| 12 | Army in 1944, arriving in France to take part in the Battle of the Bulge; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, he slept in houses, barns, and foxholes to protect himself from frigid |
| 14 | temperatures and snowstorms; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, his valiant and courageous service contributed to the liberation of |
| 16 | France during World War II as a member of the 291st Infantry Regiment, and Lt. Col. |
| 17 | Lazarus participated in the entire campaign of his regiment, particularly to the Bastille de |
| 18 | la Poche Colmar and the assault through the Foret Domaniale on February 3, 1945; and |
