ABORTION

OR NO IMPACT See Note

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(Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits the use of public monies for abortion and provision of public monies to providers of abortion except as may be required by the federal government as a condition of federal financial participation in a public

Proposed bill provides that no public monies of state or local governmental entities shall be used in any way for, to assist in, or to provide facilities for abortion, except when the abortion is medically necessary to prevent the death of the mother or when the use of monies is a required condition of federal financial participation in a public medical assistance program. This bill provides for submission to the voters at the statewide election to be held November 4, 2014.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

This bill specifies that no public monies shall be used in any way for, to assist in, or to provide facilities for an abortion, except when the abortion is medically necessary to prevent death of the mother or when such use of monies is required as a condition of federal financial participation in a public medical assistance program. Thus, there is no anticipated impact to various health agencies related to the enactment of this bill.

The proposed constitutional amendment will be considered by voters at the statewide election to be held on November 4, 2014. The Secretary of State may incur minimal ballot printing costs associated with this measure. However, as a regular practice, the Secretary of State typically budgets for up to 10 constitutional amendments for the fall statewide elections.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
