**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Implementation of the proposed legislation will result in an indeterminable decrease in state general fund expenditures. The following are changes that are anticipated to reduce state expenses.

The proposed legislation would allow assigning commissioners based on the number of eligible voters in the election instead of the number of voters in the precinct. The possible savings would be less staffing necessary per precinct.

Another change would provide that the list of commissioner's-in-charge that are selected, the clerks of court shall enter the list in the state voter registration system instead of mailing them. The savings reflected above is the cost to the clerks of court for printing and postage.

The Secretary of State would eliminate the duplicate form for payroll affidavit in favor of a single form. The savings reflected above is the cost of printing for the Secretary of State.

Registrar of Voters would be given the discretion to set days and hours for early voting in additional early voting locations. The possible savings would be less staffing necessary if hours were shortened.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
