Provides relative to school bus transportation for nonpublic school students in certain parishes

The proposed legislation provides an exception to a local school board in a parish with a population between 110,000 and 115,000 by not requiring the school board to provide free transportation for any student attending a non-public school if either the cost incurred or distance traveled exceed that for providing transportation for students attending public schools.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The bill would reduce costs for a parish school board by an indeterminable amount as a result of not providing free transportation to certain students in non-public schools. The extent of any savings would be determined by the number of students who would otherwise be afforded the free transportation. Based on the 2010 federal census, Terrebonne is the only parish with a population between 110,000 and 115,000.
