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Revises terminology referring to persons with disabilities and other persons with exceptionalities

<u>Proposed law</u> revises terminology in present law referring to persons with disabilities and other persons with exceptionalities by deleting and making substitutions for obsolete, derogatory, or offensive terms. In addition, the proposed law corrects names of agencies, institutions, private organizations, and other entities; removes references to offices, bureaus, and other subdivisions of state agencies and to programs and services that have otherwise been repealed or no longer exist; and makes technical changes and corrections.
