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LeBas HB No. 212

Abstract: Adds certain substances to Schedules II, III, and IV.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the designation of controlled dangerous substances into Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V based upon the substances' potential for addiction and abuse.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds 4-anilino-N-phenethyl-4-piperidine (ANPP) as an immediate precursor to fentanyl to Schedule II.

Proposed law adds perampanel, methasterone and prostanozol to Schedule III.

Proposed law adds lorcaserin and alfaxalone to Schedule IV.

(Amends R.S. 40:964(Schedule IV)(B)(1); Adds R.S. 40:964(Schedule II)(E)(3), (Schedule III)(B)(15), (29.1), and (53.1), (Schedule IV)(B)(1.5) and (Schedule IV)(D)(13))
