Prohibits preferences in the provision of state services and other benefits based on the location of a citizen's residence

Proposed legislation prohibits any state agency in the executive branch receiving an appropriation through the general appropriations bill, ancillary appropriation bill or any supplemental appropriation bill from exercising any policy involving a preference in the provision of services or other benefits based on the location of a citizen's residence. Proposed legislation provide that this law shall not apply to any agency specifically authorized by law to give preference to or otherwise limit
