HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Badon to Engrossed House Bill No. 347 by Representative Badon

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, delete line 11 in its entirety and insert the following:

"(2) As an alternate means of compliance with the requirements of 49 CFR, the owner or operator of a motor vehicle truck tractor may opt to obtain a Louisiana motor commercial motor vehicle inspection certificate which satisfies the requirements of 49 CFR 396.17. A trailer or semitrailer being used in combination with a truck tractor meeting such exemption may opt to obtain a Louisiana commercial motor vehicle inspection certificate which satisfies the requirements of 49 CFR 396.17.

(3) As used in this Section, "commercial motor vehicle" means any self-propelled truck tractor or towed vehicle which is used on public highways to transport property in interstate commerce, has been issued an apportioned plate through the International Registration Plan; and

(a) Has a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) or gross combination weight rating (GCWR) of 10,001 pounds or more; or

(b) Is used in the transportation of hazardous materials in quantity requiring placarding under regulations issued by the secretary under the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act (49 USC app. 1801-1813)."
