2	To enact R.S. 33:447.13, relative to the mayor's court of the town of Rosepine; to authorize

5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 33:447.13 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§447.13. Mayor's court; town of Rosepine; additional court costs
8	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the mayor
9	of the town of Rosepine may impose court costs not to exceed thirty dollars for
10	each offense, as defined by ordinance, on any defendant convicted of a violation
11	of a municipal ordinance. The court costs authorized by this Section shall be
12	in addition to the court costs authorized by R.S. 33:441.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes mayor's courts in municipalities to try all violations of municipal ordinances and to impose court costs not to exceed \$30 for each offense as defined by
