1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To express the sincere condolences of the Legislature of Louisiana upon the death of
3	Michael Hal Martin, Lafourche Parish tax assessor.
4	WHEREAS, it is with deep regret and profound sorrow that the citizens of Louisiana
5	learned of the death of Michael Hal Martin on March 4, 2014, at the age of fifty-eight; and
6	WHEREAS, Michael Hal Martin was born on October 17, 1955, to Leroy and Dot
7	Martin; and
8	WHEREAS, he was a native and resident of Galliano, Louisiana; and
9	WHEREAS, he graduated from South Lafourche High School in 1973 and attended
10	Nicholls State University where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Business
11	Administration in 1979; and
12	WHEREAS, Mr. Martin attended Southern University Law Center in Baton Rouge
13	and earned a Juris Doctor in 1982; and
14	WHEREAS, in 1980, he married his childhood sweetheart, Tammy Lathrop, and in
15	1985, they welcomed a son, Hal; and
16	WHEREAS, upon graduation from law school, Mr. Martin began a private law
17	practice in Galliano, and in 1988 was appointed as an assistant district attorney; and
18	WHEREAS, in 1999, he was elected as the assessor of Lafourche Parish and

1	subsequently reelected in 2003, 2007, and 2011, without opposition; and
2	WHEREAS, Mr. Martin was a certified Louisiana assessor, a member of the
3	Louisiana Assessors' Association, and a member of the International Association of
4	Assessing Officers; and
5	WHEREAS, he served on the Louisiana Assessors' Association's oil and gas,
6	watercraft, constitution and legal study, legislative, and insurance committees, as well as its
7	president in 2009; and
8	WHEREAS, Mr. Martin was past president of the Lafourche Parish Bar Association,
9	the Lafourche Chamber of Commerce, the Rotary Club, and co-chairman of the American
10	Cancer Society; and
11	WHEREAS, he was a member of the Adjudicated Properties Committee at the
12	Louisiana State Law Institute, the Thibodaux Chamber of Commerce, the Lafourche
13	Chamber of Commerce, the Bayou Industrial Group, the Louisiana Organ Procurement
14	Agency, the Knights of Columbus, the Nicholls State Alumni Association, Delta Theta Phi
15	Law Fraternity, and was the incorporator of Casa Hope, Inc.; and
16	WHEREAS, Michael Hal Martin is survived by his wife of thirty-three years,
17	Tammy; a son, Hal Michael Martin; his parents, Leroy and Dot Martin; a brother, Perry
18	Martin; and a sister, Lisa Martin; and
19	WHEREAS, with the death of Michael Hal Martin, Louisiana has lost one of its
20	finest sons, a quintessential southern gentleman who loved his community and a man whose
21	accomplishments have left an indelible mark upon his community, state, and nation; and
22	WHEREAS, the death of Michael Hal Martin has left a substantial void in the
23	Galliano community and a sense of loss in the citizens whose lives he touched, and his
24	memory shall live forever in the minds and hearts of all those who knew and loved this
25	remarkable gentleman.
26	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
27	express sincere and heartfelt condolences upon the death of Michael Hal Martin of Galliano,
28	records for posterity his outstanding achievements, and extends enduring appreciation for
29	the tremendous pride and honor that he will forever bring to the Galliano community, the
30	state of Louisiana, and the United States of America.
