Gary Smith (SB 417)

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the issuance of title for a vehicle whose power train, computer, or electrical system has sustained water damage, but does not meet the criteria for a salvaged vehicle, or a certificate of destruction.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a branded title to be issued indicating the vehicle has sustained water damage.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to promulgate rules necessary to implement and enforce branded title for water damage vehicle.

Effective August 1, 2014.
