Abstract: Allows day or night taking of feral hogs on private property year round.

<u>Present law</u> allows taking of outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, and beaver on private property at night by the landowner or lessee or agent with written permission and the landowner's contact information on his person. Such taking is limited to the period of time from the last day of February to the last day of August each year.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows taking of feral hogs by any means except with the use of dogs at night from Sept. 1 through the last day of Feb., on private property by the landowner or lessee or agent. Allows such taking at any time of the year, during daylight or nighttime hours.
