HIGHWAYS: Designates a portion of Interstate 49 as the "Slow Down Speed Trap Area"

1 AN ACT 2 To designate a portion of Interstate 49 in St. Landry Parish as the "Slow Down Speed Trap 3 Area". 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 5 Section 1. The portion of Interstate 49 in St. Landry Parish, beginning one and one-6 half miles north and extending one and one-half miles south of Exit 25, which intersects with 7 Louisiana Highway 103, shall be hereinafter known and designated as the "Slow Down 8 Speed Trap Area". 9 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development and its contractors 10 are hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation.

Seabaugh HB No. 1250

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting the highway designation.
