4	only vehicles subject to or targeted for inspection are motorcycles; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 32:295.4(5) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§295.4. Guidelines for seat belt and motor vehicle liability security checkpoints;
9	law enforcement agencies
10	All law enforcement agencies involved in traffic enforcement shall establish
11	guidelines for the operation of seat belt checkpoints and proof of compulsory motor
12	vehicle liability security checkpoints. Such guidelines shall include but not be
13	limited to the following provisions:
14	* * *
15	(5) Provisions prohibiting the establishment of checkpoints where the
16	only vehicles subject to or targeted for inspection are motorcycles, as defined
17	in R.S. 32:1(38).

<u>Present law</u> requires law enforcement agencies to establish guidelines for the operation of seat belt checkpoints and proof of compulsory motor vehicle liability insurance checkpoints.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and requires law enforcement agencies to establish guidelines prohibiting the establishment of checkpoints where the only vehicles subject to or targeted for inspection are motorcycles, as defined by law.
