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HEALTH CARE OR NO IMPACT See Note
Provides relative to enforcement of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits an agency, officer, or employee of this state, acting on behalf of the state, from engaging in an activity that aids any agency in the enforcement of those provisions of Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 (PPACA) and any subsequent federal act that amends PPACA that exceed the authority of the United States Constitution.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the attorney general, whenever there is reasonable cause to believe that a person or business in this state is being harmed by implementation of PPACA and that proceedings would be in the public interest, to bring an action in the name of the state against the person or entity causing the harm to restrain by temporary restraining order, temporary injunction, or permanent injunction the use of the method, act, or practice.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the state of La. or a political subdivision including but not limited to parishes, municipalities, or special districts of the state from establishing a health care exchange for the purchase of health insurance or from participating in or purchasing insurance from a health care exchange established by a nonprofit organization.
