RE +\$52,000 GF EX See Note

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Provides that a person who is not affiliated with any political party is designated as "independent" instead of "no party" on voter registration records, a notice of candidacy, and a ballot

<u>Present law</u> provides requirements and procedures for a political party to become a recognized political party. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>. <u>Present law</u> provides that no political party shall be recognized which declares its name to be solely to be "Independent" or "the Independent Party". <u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u>. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2015.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The Secretary of State would incur one-time cost in the amount of approximately \$52,000 in FY 15. The legislation would require programming changes for Voter Registration and its associated reports. Two web applications must also be modified (Online Voter Registration and Agency Voter Registration), as well as the related electronic forms. The department's existing vendor currently charges approximately \$100 per hour for programming and the department estimates approximately \$100 hours of work is necessary to make these changes (520 hours \$x\$ \$100 = \$52,000).

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
