MTR VEHICLE/WINDSHIELDS: Extends the medical exemption to the area below the top six inches of a vehicle windshield if authorized by an optometrist or a physician

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 32:361.2(D), relative to medical exemptions applicable to
3	operating a motor vehicle; to provide that the medical exemption shall apply to the
4	top area of a motor vehicle windshield with the required medical authorization; and
5	to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 32:361.2(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§361.2. Medical exemption

10	D. Any exemption granted pursuant to this Section shall not apply to the area
11	below the top six inches of a motor vehicle windshield unless specifically authorized
12	by the optometrist or physician granting or requesting the medical exemption
13	provided for in this Section for a patient who is diagnosed with a light sensitive
14	porphyria.

Lopinto HB No. 1127

Abstract: Allows the medical exemption for the area below the top six inches of a vehicle windshield to apply for a patient diagnosed with a light sensitive porphyria.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits that any exemption granted pursuant to <u>present law</u> from applying to the area below the top six inches of a motor vehicle windshield.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows the medical exemption to apply to the area below the top six inches of a motor vehicle windshield if the optometrist or physician granting or requesting the medical exemption specifically authorizes it for a patient with a light sensitive porphyria.
