4	WHEREAS, it is with great pride that the citizens and the Senate of the Legislature
5	of Louisiana have learned of the unprecedented great honor achieved by the Natchitoches
6	Central High School Chiefs boys basketball team upon the completion of a sensational 2014
7	season; and wishes to congratulate the players and coaches on winning the Class 5A boy's
8	state basketball championship; and
9	WHEREAS, the Natchitoches Central Chiefs finished the 2014 season with an
10	exceptional overall record of thirty-one wins and only three losses, going out as the Class
11	5A state champions; and
12	WHEREAS, in the championship game number two ranked Natchitoches Central
13	High School defeated top-seeded Scotlandville Magnet High School 60-53 with forty-six of
14	the Chiefs' sixty points being scored inside the paint, ending Scotlandville's back-to-back
15	state title championship winning streak; and
16	WHEREAS, the Chiefs victory claimed the first Class 5A state title for a boys sport
17	at Natchitoches Central High School; and

1 WHEREAS, Austin Guy, a sophomore, led the Chiefs all year averaging 15 points 2 per game and nine rebounds; Brandon Rachal's outstanding defense averaged 3.2 steals per 3 game and was named all-district freshman; Andre Jackson, a senior standout, was named all-4 state point guard and finished district and playoff games averaging nine assists per game; 5 Danny Cohen, a junior standout, was voted All-State in the Coaches' Association polls and finished the playoffs averaging twenty points per game; and sophomore standout Cameron 6 7 Lard was MVP, receiving Outstanding Player honors in the final game in which he scored 8 twenty-four points, made ten rebounds, and had six blocks; and 9 WHEREAS, additionally, each member of the team took part in the championship 10 honors and performed at the highest level of excellence throughout the season, and each 11 deserve recognition for his vital contributions to the winning effort; and 12 WHEREAS, the victorious members of the Natchitoches Central Chiefs High School 13 boys basketball team consists of Ricky Metoyer, Danny Cohen, Donald Rachal, Darian 14 Raymond, Andre Jackson, Austin Guy, Darien Jones, Chris Burks, Brandon Rachal, Michael Johnson, Keyth Johnson, Cameron Lard, Kimani Benjamin, Dyllon Weaver, and Decorrius 15 16 Anderson, and managers Kolby Carter, Trey Reed, Ryan Woodard, JJ Payne, and Marquis King, trainer Lennis Watson, and statistician Warren Massia; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Head Coach Micah Coleman, along with assistant coaches Kolton 19 Sepulvado and Darius Burton have instilled in their players the kind of leadership and motivational skills needed to succeed both on and off the court; and 20
