ROADS/HIGHWAYS. Requests DOTD and DOAF to identify and mark farm to market highways in Louisiana.

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development and the Department of Agriculture and Forestry to cooperate with the Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation, Inc., to identify and mark farm to market highways in Louisiana.

WHEREAS, agriculture is the backbone of Louisiana's economy; and

WHEREAS, the agricultural industry contributes significantly to Louisiana's economy and has the potential to contribute even more economic benefits and job creation; and

WHEREAS, other states, notably Texas, identify and mark farm to market highways; and

WHEREAS, identifying and marking Louisiana's farm to market highways would benefit the agricultural industry.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development and the Department of Agriculture and Forestry to cooperate with the Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation, Inc., to identify and mark farm to market highways in Louisiana.
