2	To commend the Brusly High School Panthers wrestling team on winning its third
3	consecutive Division III state championship title.
4	WHEREAS, during the 1977-1978 school year, Coach Phil Bode began training the
5	first Brusly High School wrestling team by placing horsehair mats on the ground near the
6	gymnasium; and
7	WHEREAS, Coach Bode purchased the first wrestling mat for Brusly High School
8	with his own money; and
9	WHEREAS, for the past thirty-seven years, Brusly High School has enjoyed a rich
10	tradition of producing one hundred seven individual state champions and thirteen team titles;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, during the 2013-2014 school year, the Brusly High School Panthers
13	wrestling team earned the Division III championship title for the third consecutive year and
14	claimed its tenth state title in ten years; and
15	WHEREAS, the Panthers distinguished themselves from the rest of the field by
16	setting a new Louisiana High School Athletic Association state wrestling composite record
17	with a team total of 343.5; and
18	WHEREAS, Brusly Panther Trevor Schermer, the 152-pound class winner, was

1	$selected\ as\ the\ Division\ III\ Outstanding\ Wrestler\ and\ Greater\ Baton\ Rouge\ All-Metro\ MVP;$

3	WHEREAS, the Panthers had eleven wrestlers in the finals of the fourteen different
4	weight classes and won all but one match; and
5	WHEREAS, Coach Jimmy Bible was named Times-Picayune Coach of the Year as
6	well as Greater Baton Rouge All-Metro Coach of the Year, which is an honor he has
7	received eleven times; and
8	WHEREAS, the members of the wrestling team performed at the highest level of
9	athletic excellence throughout the season and each of them deserves recognition for their
10	vital contributions to the Panthers' winning effort; and
11	WHEREAS, Coaches Bible, Sutherland and Wilson instilled an ethic of winning and
12	demonstrated the kind of leadership and motivational skills needed to produce winners both
13	on and off the mat; and
14	WHEREAS, the Brusly High School Panthers wrestling team has earned well-
15	deserved accolades throughout the season for the extraordinary athletic abilities the team has
16	displayed, particularly at the most difficult level of high school competition.
