R.S. 33:4690.13 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §4690.13. Additional notice to certain property owners 8 A. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, in addition to 9 any notice required by law relative to a pending public works project by any 10 parish or municipality, and at least ten days prior to the public hearing, a good 11 faith attempt to notify the owner or owners of record of the property directly affected by the public works project may be made by sending an official notice 12 13 by United States mail of the time and place of the public hearing and the general 14 subject matter of the proposed public works project. B. In addition to any current provision of law regarding notice relative 15 to a public hearing related to pending public works projects, the state and 16 17 political subdivisions of the state may adopt policies to give additional notice to the owner of record of the property directly affected by the proposed public
works project. The notice shall be made by sending an official notice by United

States mail at least ten business days prior to the time and place of the public
hearing and the general subject matter of the proposed public works project.

## **DIGEST**

Mills (SB 183)

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that an additional notice requirement may be sent via United States mail, 10 days prior to a public hearing, to property owners whose property will be affected by any parish's or municipality's public works project.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a state or any political subdivision of the state may adopt policies to provide additional notice to the owner of record of property about their property that will be directly affected by any public works projects. Further provides that the notice shall be made sent by U.S. mail at least 10 days prior to the time and place of the public hearing regarding the public works project.

Effective August 1, 2014.
