10	(48) To questionnaires completed by members of a petit jury venire or
11	grand jury venire, whether completed pursuant to the Code of Criminal
12	<b>Procedure Art. 416.1 or upon response to a subpoena to jury service. This shall</b>
13	not prohibit the dissemination of such questionnaires to counsel for parties to
14	a case for use in litigation as directed by the court with jurisdiction. This shall
15	not prohibit the dissemination of venire lists as required by the Code of
16	Criminal Procedure Art. 417.

## DIGEST

Peacock (SB 353)

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts records and personal information of individuals called to jury service and individuals serving on a jury from the Public Records Law.

<u>Proposed law</u> does not prohibit dissemination of jury questionnaires to counsel for parties to a case for use in litigation as directed by the court with jurisdiction or the dissemination of venire lists as required by the Code of Criminal Procedure Art. 417.
