Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs to Original Senate Bill No. 121 by Senator Morrell

## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, line 2, after "and (9)" insert "and to enact R.S. 37:1116(E)"

- 4 On page 1, line 6, after "reenacted" insert "and R.S. 37:1116(E) is hereby enacted"
- 5 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 6 On page 2, delete lines 9 through 13 and insert the following:
- 7 "§1116. Licensure application for marriage and family therapists; temporary license

10 E. A licensed marriage and family therapist engaged in the diagnosis of 11 individuals shall furnish satisfactory evidence of the following to the board: 12 (1) The applicant has graduated from a program of graduate study which in 13 addition to the standard training in the professional application of 14 psychotherapeutic and family systems theories, will also require a minimum of 15 six credit hours in diagnostic psychopathology, whereas students are taught to systematically collect and analyze data based on one or both of the two standard 16 diagnostic systems employed, International Classification of Diseases, Ninth 17 **Revision or the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, Fifth** 18 Edition, for the above purposes. However, licensed marriage and family 19 20 therapists who have satisfied all other criteria for licensure as required by the 21 board on August 1, 2014, shall be allowed to diagnose individuals upon completion of the continuing education requirements of this Section. 22

23 (2) As diagnosis is constantly being enhanced by emerging empirical research,
 24 the licensed marriage and family therapist shall receive six hours of credit in
 25 continuing education that focuses on diagnosis.

26 (3) Nothing in this Chapter shall be construed to authorize any person licensed 27 under the provisions of this Chapter to assess, diagnose, or provide treatment 28 to any individual suffering from a serious mental illness, as defined by this 29 Section, when medication may be indicated, except when a licensed marriage 30 and family therapist, in accordance with best practices, consults and 31 collaborates with a practitioner who holds a license or permit with the 32 Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners or an advanced practice registered 33 nurse licensed by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing who is certified as a 34 psychiatric nurse practitioner."
