Barrow HB No. 546

Abstract: Provides for a periodic payment plan for an order of restitution for indigent defendants.

<u>Present law</u> requires the court to order a defendant to pay restitution to a crime victim in certain cases.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that if the defendant is found to be indigent and therefore unable to make restitution in full at the time of conviction, the court may order a periodic payment plan consistent with the person's financial ability.

(Adds C.Cr.P. Art. 883.2(D))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Administration of Criminal</u> Justice to the original bill.

- 1. Changed the ordering of a payment plan for indigent defendants <u>from</u> mandatory <u>to</u> permissive.
- 2. Removed the prohibition regarding incarceration for failure to pay restitution.
- 3. Removed the prohibition on the payment plan exceeding 15% of the offender's income.
