Abstract: Provides for the size and number of escape rings on crab traps.

<u>Present law</u>, relative to escape rings on crab traps, requires at least two escape rings on the outside walls of the trap with at least one in each chamber of the trap. <u>Proposed law</u> would require three escape rings with at least two in the upper chamber of the trap.

<u>Present law</u> requires the escape rings to be no less than 2 and 5/16ths inches in diameter. <u>Proposed law</u> would change the diameter to 2 and 3/8ths inches.

<u>Present law</u> exempts from these requirements crab traps with a mesh of 2 and 5/16ths inches and traps in Lake Pontchartrain. <u>Proposed law</u> removes the exemption for traps placed in Lake Pontchartrain.

Effective November 15, 2017, and applicable to license year 2017 and thereafter.
