8 WHEREAS, the YMCA's core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility

9 unite volunteers and members as a movement and guide individuals' behavior, interactions

10 with each other, and decision making; and

11 WHEREAS, more than one hundred thousand children and adults throughout the

12 state have access to the essentials necessary to learn, grow and thrive; and

13 WHEREAS, Louisiana's YMCAs support the development of integrated, community-

16 provide developmental programs for youth, strengthen families, and mobilize and coordinate

20 the Louisiana State Capitol with their representatives and senators to discuss and exchange

21 ideas on issues facing youth and families.

3 commend the members and volunteers of Louisiana's YMCAs for their dedication to
