11	community-based strategies for serving children and families; and
12	WHEREAS, Louisiana's YMCAs stand ready to support state government efforts to
13	provide developmental programs for youth, strengthen families, and mobilize and coordinate
14	broad efforts to support children and families through partnerships that meet community
15	needs; and
16	WHEREAS, on April 23, 2014, representatives of Louisiana's YMCAs will meet at
17	the Louisiana State Capitol with their Senators and Representatives to discuss and exchange
18	ideas on issues facing youth and families.
