A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To recognize Wednesday, April 23, 2014, as YMCA Day in Louisiana.

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to commend the volunteers and members of the Louisiana YMCA and to recognize Wednesday, April 23, 2014, as YMCA Day in Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, one of the YMCA's core commitment's is to nurture the potential of kids, promote healthy living, and foster a sense of social responsibility; and

WHEREAS, the YMCA's core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility unite volunteers and members as a movement and guide individuals' behavior, interactions with each other, and decision making; and
