MTR VEHICLE/BUSES-SCHOOL RE NO II
Provides relative to the model age and use of school buses

The proposed legislation requires that any school bus used to transport children shall not be more than twenty-five years old and that any bus used as an activity or back up bus shall be fifteen or less model years old. Further prohibits the use of any school bus as an activity or back up bus that is older than fifteen years old from being used more than sixty consecutive days at a time.
