2 On page 2, after line 13, insert the following:

"§607. Adulterated food

D For purp

D. For purposes of this Section:

(1) Anyone who sells confectionery <u>or ice cream</u> that contains more than one-half of one percent alcohol rendered unfit for beverage purposes to a person who is under the legal age for purchasing alcoholic beverages shall be fined not more than three hundred dollars or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.

(2) Any confectionery manufactured or ice cream sold or offered for sale in this state that contains more than one-half of one percent alcohol rendered unfit for beverage purposes shall bear a label containing the statement: "Sale of this product to persons under the legal age for purchasing alcoholic beverages is unlawful." A person who violates the provisions of this Paragraph shall be fined not more than three hundred dollars or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.

16 (3) No confectionery ice cream containing more than one-half of one percent alcohol rendered unfit for beverage purposes shall be sold or offered for sale in this 17 state unless the product bears a label that meets the requirements of Paragraph (2) 18 of this Subsection or a sign containing the statement: "Sale of confectionery or ice 19 20 cream containing more than one-half of one percent alcohol to persons under the 21 legal age for purchasing alcoholic beverages is unlawful" is displayed at the place 22 where the product is sold or offered for sale. A person who violates the provisions 23 of this Paragraph shall be fined not more than three hundred dollars or imprisoned 24 for not more than six months, or both." 25
